#### **Braille On Demand**

The National Library Service for the Blind and Print Disabled (NLS) offers a Braille-On-Demand program that allows Braille readers to request and keep one Braille book per month. These personal Braille book copies are yours to keep. There are over 16,000 eBraille titles currently available on BARD, and any can be printed on demand and sent to your home.

Order one Braille-On-Demand book per month by completing a short online form at: *surveymonkey. com/r/NLSbrailleondemand*. For assistance in ordering a book, call OTBS staff at 248-650-5681 or send an email to *otbs@rhpl.org*. After your request is processed, you will receive a hard copy of your chosen Braille book, bound with a soft cover and comb-binding, through the mail.

Please note that you may continue to request Braille books as usual, and that books belonging to the Braille and Talking Book Library must still be returned. Only Braille-On-Demand books may be kept. Call 248-650-5681 for more information.

BARD: Braille and Audio Reading Materials Updates and Improvements

BARD Mobile, the free application for smartphones and tablets, provides OTBS patrons with immediate access to our complete selection of talking books and magazines. Using this app, you may download up to 100 items in a 30-day period. You may keep the books you download on your device as long as you need.

In late 2022, significant improvements were made to the searching and downloading process. Search results are now more accurate and easier to navigate. Adding a book to the wish list and downloading it has been eliminated for those using Apple devices. These improvements will be implemented for other operating systems (Android), as well. You must update the BARD mobile app on your device to activate these changes.

The written descriptions of books will now come directly from the publisher, providing the user with more detailed information.
