Large Print Books & Audio-Described Videos by Mail

OTBS patrons can receive large print books and audio-described videos by mail. Rochester Hills Public Library owns thousands of fiction and nonfiction large print books.

Audio-described videos are DVDs that contain an additional audio track that describes the film's visual elements. The action, characters, locations, costumes, and sets are audibly described without interfering with the dialogue or sound effects. Note: only DVDs that contain an audio track designed to enhance the experience for those with visual impairments are eligible for mail service.
